## PICTURE GUIDE

Photo Documentation of your room helps us see the full picture.

To make our Plum Design Solution as comprehensive as possible, we prefer to have pictures of your room empty. Keep fixtures and wall sconces that you wish to keep.

### *1. Perspective Photos*

- Stand as far back in your room as you can. Move into the corner of the room and take a picture of the opposite corner, capturing the 2 side wall and as much of the room as possible.
- Repeat 3 times, capturing the entire room.
- If the room is an odd shape and there are parts of the room that are not captured in the pictures, make sure to take extra shots to show the whole room.



## 2. Wall Elevation Photos

- Again, stand as far back as you can and take a picture straight on of you wall, making sure to capture a little bit of the floor, ceiling and 2 adjacent walls.
- Repeat with the remaining 3 walls
- If the room is an odd shape and there are parts of the room that are not captured in the pictures, make sure to take extra shots of those walls



### *Plum Tricks for Photographing your Room*

- If possible, move the furniture you currently have in the room out of the room or to the side of the room that won't be in the photograph. Felt pads or even a tea towel placed under the legs of the furniture will make it easy for one person to do the job and will protect your floors.
- Take the pictures in the daytime to make sure the shots are bright and crisp.
- Check your results and retake any pictures that might be fuzzy
